God's Purpose for Government Romans 13:3,4

1,2, the reason for obeying the government = its divine origin. 3,4, the reason for obeying the government = its divine purpose.

Purpose #1: to offer praise for doing good, 3

*Reassurance = rulers actually promotes good behavior. Rulers should provide a good social order, Prov.16:10-12, 20:8. *Rhetorical question: doing good results in praise not fear.

Purpose #2: to administer punishment for doing evil, 4

*Warning = evil behavior will invite punishment. *Governing rulers = God's servants (diakonos)! Jer. 25:9. *God's wrath/vengeance (cf.12:19) is accomplished by rulers. *The sword implies violence--including capital punishment.

*Common reasons for rejecting capital punishment:

-It's inhumane, unenlightened and unconstitutional.
-It's unchristian/unforgiving. Jesus said love your enemies.
-OT had CP for numerous sins plus OT exceptions.
-It's unfairly administered and is not a deterrent.
-Innocent people may be executed.
-Our aim should be rehabilitation.

*<u>Convincing reasons for promoting capital punishment:</u> -Also see Gen. 9:6, Lev. 24:17, Deut. 19:11-13, Acts 25:11. -It actually does deter murder and protects innocent lives. -It shows more respect for the victim than the criminal. -Our aim should be retribution as Scripture teaches.
