

What We All Need **Romans 15:14-21**

We all need to be able to admonish one another. 14

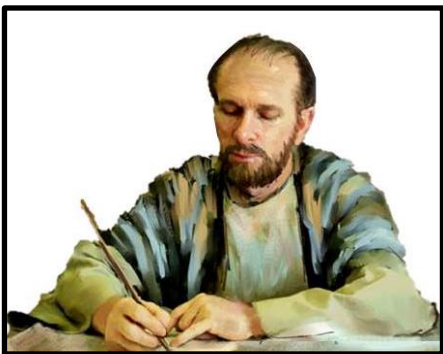
- ◆ Here is where Paul's conclusion to Romans begins.
- ◆ Why is Paul so confident in this group in view of the issue raised in 14:1-15:13? See 1:8 and Gal. 5:10, II Cor. 7:4.
- ◆ Admonishing = warning/motivating fellow believers to do what is right, I Cor. 4:14, I Thess. 5:14, II Thess. 3:15.
- ◆ Are you able to admonish other believers when needed?

We all need to be reminded of truths we know. 15a

- ◆ Note Paul hasn't been to this church (1:10, 15:22,23) so his *reminding* is on top of teachings by others, 16:3-5.
- ◆ What are the *points* Paul appeared to have in mind?

We all need to be fulfilling our area of ministry. 15b-21

- ◆ Paul's special calling (1:5) is why he can write as he has.
- ◆ Compare the phrase *grace given* in 15:b to 12:6.
- ◆ Notice Paul feels comfortable boasting about how God has been able to use him to reach the lost. How might this apply to us?
