Updating Your Faith Acts 18:23-19:7

A gifted preacher needs to be updated. 18:23-28

 Apollos has a very impressive resume, but he's 20 years behind the times!
 Why interrupt Paul's 3rd missionary journey with an episode featuring Apollos? Note their paths crisscross (I Cor. 1:12, 3:5,6) plus a link with John the Baptist.

Twelve disciples need to be updated. 19:1-7

OLike Apollos these 12 are behind the times, which leads to Paul's questions. Are these fellows Christians? This is a hard group and passage to figure out!
OSome see 9:1-7 and ch. 2, 8, 10 to indicate a present day pattern for a "2nd blessing" of the Holy Spirit, featuring speaking in tongues for all believers.
OProblems exist for seeing these unique events as a pattern beyond Acts: -Holy Spirit is received at salvation, Eph. 1:13, Rom. 8:9, I Cor. 12:13.
Tongues were called a gift and not for all believers, I Cor.12:13,30.
-Recall Acts is historical and transitional with many unique events, e.g. Acts 4 common property, Acts 5 deaths, Acts 9 resuscitation.

We sometimes need to be updated.
