Biggest Losers in the Bible Caiaphas

He rejected John the Baptist's ministry.

- ❖ Caiaphas is the officially appointed and recognized high priest, though his father-in-law (Annas) still wields much power, Lk. 3:2, Jn. 18:13, Acts 4:6.
- ❖ Caiaphas and the religious establishment rejected John, Matt. 21:23-25.

He opposed Jesus' ministry and condemned Him to death.

- ❖ Jesus is targeted by the religious leaders for healing on the Sabbath, Mk. 3: 5,6. After raising Lazarus, Caiaphas argues Jesus must die, Jn. 11:45-50.
- ❖At Caiaphas' home a plot is hatched to seize Jesus and to kill Him, Matt. 26: 3-5. Once seized, Jesus is taken to Caiaphas' home for an illegal trial, Matt. 26:57,58 and condemned to be worthy of death, Matt. 26:62-66.
- ❖It is these religious leaders who charge Jesus before Pilate, Matt. 27:12; and it is they who incite the crowds to crucify Him, Matt. 27:20.

He persecuted the early church

- ❖ Caiaphas leads the counsel in warning Peter and John, Acts 4:6ff.
- ❖Caiaphas would have killed the apostles if not for Gamaliel's words, 5:17,33ff.
- ❖Caiaphas was presiding when Stephen was killed, 8:1ff.
- ❖Caiaphas gave Paul authority to persecute believers, 9:1,2, 22:5
