## I am the Light of the World John 8:12

Jesus claims to be the light of the world several times. See also 3:19-21, 9:5, 12:35,36,46, 1:4-10, but only Jn. 8:12 records Jesus using the emphatic *l am*. Note repeated contrast with *darkness*.

What was Jesus suggesting by His claim to be light? Consider the physical, ethical, and spiritual nuances of light. Jesus exposed sin and enlightened us, as was predicted in Isa. 9:1,2, Lk.2: 2;32. Why are so many still in the dark: Jn. 3:19-20, Il Cor. 4:4-6.

What else does Jesus' claim to be light suggest? See Ps. 27:1, Mic. 7:8, Job: 2,3, I Jn. 1:5 plus Matt. 17:2, Acts 22:6-8, Rev. 21:23-25.

What is our responsibility because of Jesus' claim here? How is this "I am" claim by Jesus so different for us compared to Jesus' other "I am" claims? Check out passages like Jn. 5:35, Isa 49:6, Matt. 5:14-16, I Thess. 5:5, Phil. 2:15, Eph. 5:7-13, Acts 13:47, 26:18, I Pt. 2:9
