## An Introduction to Judges Judges 1:-1-20

## A mutilation that is disturbing in spite of great victories, 1-10 Recall Josh. 10:25. Compare Adoni-bezek's response to his treatment to the response of Gideon in 6:13. How are they different?

## A marriage that you can truly feel good about, 11-15

\*Recall I Chron. 11:6, where David also offers a prize for taking a city.

\*What does this episode tell us about Caleb, Othniel, and Achsah? Compare this early marriage to those in 21:8ff. and to 3:6,16:5ff.

\*It's pretty impressive that Caleb was Kenizzite, Josh 14:6,14.

## A major campaign that goes well but ultimately fails, 16-20

\*The Kenites (16) were given land for their earlier help, Num. 10:29-32.

\*Why can't iron chariots be the sole reason for this failure? See in Josh. 11:4-9, 17:16-18. Things really start going downhill from here.

\*The victory in v.10 over the giant sons of Anak (Dt. 9:2) is clarified here in v.20 as being led by Caleb himself, which made Hebron his.
