WHEN A FEW IS MORE THAN ENOUGH Judges 6:33-7:25

Gideon tests God by putting out a fleece. 6:33-40

- ♦ Recall God's previous promise of victory and sign in 6:14,17-22.
- ♦ Why seek a sign having to do with a threshing floor, fleece and dew?
- ♦ Is "putting out a fleece" to know God's will a good idea for us to do?

God tests Gideon by limiting him to few troops. 7:1-15

- ♦ Test #1 = Troop strength is drastically reduced, see Dt. 20:1ff.
 Rationale for reducing troops is to reduce boasting.
- ◆ Test #2 = God reduces troops to a ridiculous size (450 to 1).
- ◆ God grants an unsolicited faith-booster through two Midianites (pagan dreams from God, Gen. 20:3-6,Dan. 2:1-3). Note irony!

God enables Gideon's few troops to win the battle. 7:16-25

- ♦ See confused self-destruction also in II Chron. 20:23, I Sam 14:20.
- ◆ Ps. 83:9ff. and Isa. 9:4 recall this, and Gideon is listed in Heb. 11:32 . What did Gideon learn here that we should learn as well?
