A Warning, a Promise, and a Prayer Romans 16:17-20

Warning: Watch out for false teachers. 17-19

•The NT often warns and describes false teachers. Here Paul offers some telltale signs of a false teacher:

Their motivation: Jude 12ff., Acts 20:29,30, Col. 2:8

Their message: II Tim. 4:3-4, II Pt. 3:16

Their master: Phil. 3:19, II PT. 2:1-3, Titus 1:11

Their method: Jude 16, Col. 2:4, I Thess. 2:3-5

Their main targets: the naïve/innocent/trusting

•We are to shun false teachers, cf. Titus 3:10, II Jn. 10.

•Though Paul is excited about the church at Rome (1:8), they must be wise since false teachers are deceptive, Matt. 10:16.

Promise: God will crush Satan under our feet. 20a

- •Why mention Satan here? It's the first time in Romans.
- ●Paul' prediction here recalls Gen. 3:15. And, as usual, this event is seen as imminent, 13:12, Js. 5:9, Rev. 1:3, 22:20.

Prayer: The Grace of the Lord Jesus be with you. 20b

As in 1:7, Paul issues a prayer-wish upon the Roman church.
