God's Expectations for Kids and Dads Eph. 6:1-4

Children, obey your parents. 6:1-3

Motivations for obedience:

It is right to do. It expresses God's will, 5:17 and it pleases Him, Col. 3:20.

It brings success and lengthens life. This = 5^{th} commandment, Ex. 20:12. See Lv.19:3, Dt. 21:18-21, 27:16. Proverbs 1:15ff., 3:1,2, 6:20-23, 23:14, 30:17 reinforces this. To obey = honor.

Dads, don't provoke your children but discipline them biblically. 6:4

Negatively: Why is the focus just on fathers as in Col. 3:21? What are some things that fathers should avoid doing that might provoke their children to anger or to "lose heart" as Col. 3:21 warns about?

<u>Positively</u>: Nurture them in the *discipline* (Heb. 12:5/Prov. 3: 11) and *corrective instruction* (used in Titus 3:10) of the Lord. Mothers involved too (Prov. 1:8,9), but this responsibility falls heaviest on fathers as head of the house. What might this look like?
