## I Tim. 4:11-16

Necessary qualities teachers must have to gain respect, 12
Recall Timothy was in his early thirties, which was young at this time.
$*$ Must-have qualities in order to be an example, as w/Titus, 2:7:
$\checkmark$ Speech, 5:13, Titus 2:8, Eph. 4:25,29, 5:4
$\checkmark$ Conduct, Heb. 13:7, I Pt. 1:15
$\checkmark$ Love and Faith, 1:5, 2:15, 6:11, II Tim. 2:22, 3:10
$\checkmark$ Purity, 5:2,11, II Tim. 3:6,
Necessary goals for teachers who want to save lives, 11, 13-15
Recall issue in Ephesus was false teaching thus this focus in 11-16. *Must-have goals for Timothy (and all good teachers):
$\checkmark$ Refute false teachings (these things = previous context).
$\checkmark$ Address topics like those listed in this epistle and others.
$\checkmark$ Read the Bible publically with exhortations, cf. Acts 13:15,16.
$\checkmark$ Work hard to progress in this gift (II Tim. 1:6, II Tim. 2:15).
$\checkmark$ Understand what is at stake for yourself and those who listen to your teaching-salvation itself! What is the "salvation" here for Timothy and others (Ezek. 33:9)? To obtain it one must continue in Timothy's teaching. See similarity to 2:15, Phil. 2:12,13, plus consider Mk. 8:35, Prov. 10:11, 18:21. Teachers can be ...
