- ◆ God is described as spirit and is thus invisible, Jn. 1:18, 4:24, I Tim. 1:17, Col. 1:15.
- ◆ God can take a form, Jn. 14:7,8, Gen. 18:1, 32:30, Jdgs. 13:22.
- ◆ This concept was tough for the idol-loving ancients, and thus commandments to honor God alone and with no graven images.
- ◆ How hard is this concept for us today? What might we be more likely to do than to shape a physical image of God?

- ◆ God acting like . . . Isa. 42:14, 49:15, 66:13, Lk. 13:34
