Heaven is called “paradise / better than...” II Cor. 5:8, 12:4, Phil. 1:23.  
Heaven is seen in Isa. 6, Ezek. 1,2, Dan. 7:13-16, Rev. 4,5, 11:1-19.  
Heaven is described clearest in Rev. 21,22 (Eternal New Jerusalem).
