

## ***Predictions, Passover, and Denial*** **Mark 14:12-31**

### ***Passover room: Jesus predicts its provision. 12-16***

- ◆ Is this rendezvous prearranged or predicted, 11:1-6?
- ◆ How does Jesus' approach to this week clarify which it is?

### ***Prediction: one will betray Jesus. 17-21***

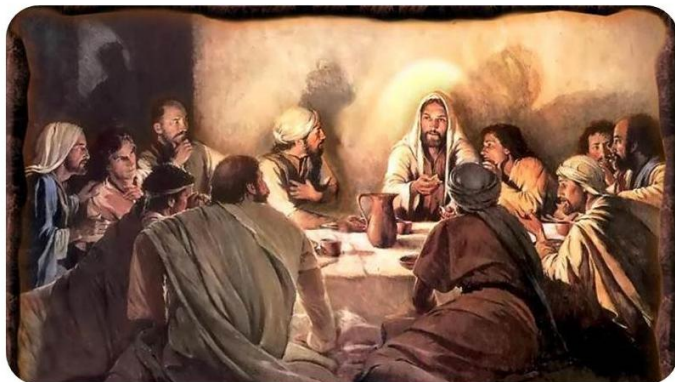
- ◆ Why drop this predictive bomb about a betrayer, Jn. 13:18,19?
- ◆ This predicted betrayal was no surprise, Ps. 41:9, Jn. 6:69,70.

### ***Passover meal: Jesus affirms His covenant. 22-26***

- ◆ Only Lk. 22:19,20 mentions repeating this event and that it represents a new covenant. Later instructions in I Cor. 11:25.
- ◆ Yet another prediction—no more wine till the kingdom of God.

### ***Prediction: all will fall away from Jesus. 27-31***

- ◆ Lk. (22:31-34) and Jn. (13:36-39) place this earlier than in Matt. / Mk. (a repeated prediction or condensed by later two).
- ◆ Jesus predicted this as did the OT in Zech. 13:7 so why all the denial and resolute bravado here?
- ◆ What does denial keep one from doing?
- ◆ What does Jesus do that good leaders also must do?
- ◆ Even knowing of the 11's failure, note Jesus' attitude.
