What are some unbiblical views embraced about death and hell?

3. Purgatory: Hell-light is temporary, less evil folks are purified.
4. Annihilationsim: Hell is temporary, evil folks are destroyed.
5. Universalism: Hell is temporary, evil folks are all saved.
6. Restitutionism: Hell is temporary, evil folks and demons are saved.
