

The Infinity of God

God's presence is everywhere (He is omnipresent).

- God can't be contained, Isa. 66:1, II Chron. 2:6, Acts 17:24,25.
- God can "jump into the picture," Gen. 28, Ex.19, I Cor.6:19; while infinite He can be intimate, Jn. 14:21, 17:20,21, Js. 4:8.
- God's presence should bring courage / confidence (Ps. 23:4, 139:7-10, Rom. 8:35) & motivation, Jer. 23:23,24, Prov. 15:3.

God's power is unlimited (He is omnipotent).

- 56x God alone is called "Almighty One," as in Rev. 11:17.
- God's great power is repeatedly mentioned, Isa. 40:25,26, Jer. 32:17, Job 41:1,2, Matt.19:26.
- God's omnipotence is seen in three ways:
 - 1) Miracles—Gen. 18:14, Lk. 1:37, Ex. 14:21, Mk. 4:39-41
 - 2) History—Gen. 15:13-16, Acts 17:26, Isa. 44:28, 45:1,4
 - 3) Hearts—Moses, David, Mary M., Paul, etc.

Omnipotence should bring confidence, but some complain:
"If God is omnipotent, then can He . . . ?"

"If God is omnipotent, then why does He . . . ?"
