## The Real Cost of Following the Real Jesus Mark 8:27-38

The 12 finally figure out Jesus is the Messiah—but now begins the hard-to-swallow explanations of His fate and what it will cost to follow Him.

Question: Who do people / you say that I am? 7:27-30 Lots of opinions here. Why secrecy still pushed (cf. 1:34, 3:12)?

## Prediction: Jesus foretells His fate, 7:31-32a

- \*First of three times Jesus predicts His fate, 9:30-31, 10:32-24.
- \*Each time = confused reactions and a lesson on discipleship.

## Reaction: Peter protests Jesus' fate, 32b-33

\*Why does Peter rebuke Jesus (see rebuke in v. 33, 1:24, 3:12)?

\*Why does Jesus so roughly rebuke Peter in return? See Matt. 4:10, 16:23, and consider Satan's plan vs. God's.

## Lesson: Jesus explains a disciple / non-disciple's fate, 7:34-38

- \*Understanding Jesus' fate is crucial to understand a disciple's.
- \*Shocking invitation: following Jesus = a cross and self-denial! Note it's a continual process—Lk. 9:23 "daily" cross-bearing.
- \*Paradoxical proposal: lose one's life to save it, (soul = life)! Matt. 16:25 has find life. Idea in Jn. 12:27 = a significant life.
- \*Rhetorical questions: what in the world is worth one's life? A better bargain / profit seen in Lk. 12:16-21, Phil. 3:7-9.
- \*Warning of shame: J-Day, Matt. 16:27; shame in I Jn. 2:28.
