## God's Way to Greatness Mark 9:30-41

Prediction: Jesus again foretells His upcoming fate, 7:30-31

❖This = 2<sup>nd</sup> of three times Jesus predicts His fate, 8:31, 10:32-24.
❖Handed over is a divine passive, Acts 2:23, Ro. 8:32, but 3:19.

Reaction: the 12 are confused and comparing themselves, 32-34

♦ Why the fear to question Jesus and the later silence, 3:4, 8:33?

♦ Why is greatness a great goal, Matt. 5:19, 19:27-29, 25:21?

## Lesson: Jesus again offers a spiritual paradox, 35-37

- \*Each lesson after a prediction has a paradox, 8:35, 10:43,44.

  Being first = greatest / being last = being a servant

  cf. Matt. 19:30, 20:16, 23:11,12, 25:40, Lk. 13:30, 14:11, 22:26.
- \*Embracing a child illustrates a humble concern for the "lowly"; but 10:15 & Matt. 18:3 use a child to illustrate how to behave.

## Inflated egos and an independent exorcist, 38-41

- ♦ Why is this guy an unfounded concern, 3:23, Lk. 11:17-23?
- ❖See Num. 11:26-29 for a similar ministry rivalry.
