## Separate from the World; Sanctified by the Word John 17:6-19

#### Confidence in these men picked by the Father, 6-10

- Certainty of the Father's election (*the men you gave Me--3x, they are yours--2x*), which recalls Jesus' words in 10:28,29, 15:16.
- Certainty of Jesus that the disciples have responded to His words: they have kept; they have come to know; they have received; truly understood; they have believed.
- Certainty for us is an important confidence builder (Eph. 1:3-14, I Pt. 1:1-5, II Pt. 2:1-4, Rom. 8:29ff.), and for all of God's people.

## Am I confident of my response to God, and my election?

#### Concerns for their protection and sanctification 11-19

### ♦ Concerns for the disciples (11-17):

- 11) loyalty to God (keep in Your name, unlike Judas in 12b)
- 11) unified as God and Jesus are (be one as later in 21-23)
- 13) joy be made full (recall 15:11, 16:20-24)
- 15) protection from Satan (*keep them from evil one*, I Jn. 2:13ff., 3:12 / Mtt. 6:13, and see Jesus' prayer in Lk. 22:31,32)
- 17) sanctify them in the truth = Your word (3:21, 8:32) These are two opposing forces--world (13x) and God's word (4x)
- ♦ Comparison of source and mission (18, 19):
- both not of this world (1:13-14 / 3:5); both sent, 3:17, 10:36 / 15:16; both sanctified—one for death and others to . . .
- which again pertains to us, I Pt. 3:15, II Tim. 2:21, I Thess. 5:23.
