Exit Elijah and Enter Elisha II Kings 2:1-18

Elijah takes Elisha from place to place before his ascension. 1-8

- ❖Why does Elijah take this zigzagging geographical pattern (first to Bethel, then to Jericho and finally across the Jordan River)?
- ❖Doesn't it seem Elijah is encouraging Elisha's desertion? Why?
- ❖Elisha stays firmly at Elijah's side (unlike servant in I Kgs. 19:3,4).

Elisha takes Elijah's place with a double portion. 9-14

- ❖Why does Elisha ask for a double portion? "My father"--Dt. 21:17
- ❖Elisha will do many more recorded miracles than Elijah but will be completely overshadowed by him (ignored in NT but for Lk. 4:27).
- ❖Another fiery miracle--"My Father, My Father, the chariots of fire and its horseman." See same reverential words in 13:14 plus 6:17.
- ❖Crossing the Jordan proves Elisha's abilities and recalls Josh. 3:7

Elijah is no place to be found, just as Elisha predicted. 15-18

- Elisha is honored by bowing prophets, but their disagreement shows they need more convincing and can't get over Elijah yet.
- ❖ Failed search shows Elisha's accuracy (more miracles soon help).



Nobody is irreplaceable, and everybody will need to be replaced eventually.
