605 BC--Babylon takes control of Judah (Daniel and friends taken). 597 BC--Babylon returns and attacks (10,000 captives taken). 586 BC--Babylon returns and destroys city, temple, more captives).

- \*Key verse for the book of Daniel =
- \*Why "the land of Shinar" in vs. 2 to describe Babylon (not used in II Kings).

See Gen. 10:8-10, 11:1-9 and how in Zech. 5:5-11 it's the place for sin.

- \*Vessels taken from the temple in Jerusalem = trophies for Nebuchadnezzar (recall I Sam. 6) and suggest a showdown is coming (see later in 5:3).
- \*Why shouldn't we expect to see the book of Daniel made into a movie? Why is Daniel a good book to study through?
