# Baffling inscription etched by a mysterious hand, 5:5-12


\*Cocky confidence turns comic with fear!

\*Queen mother (not a wife) enters and lauds Daniel's abilities.

### Babylon falls as Daniel's interpretation predicted, 5:13-30

\*Daniel offers a history lesson to rebuke a sinful family cycle. (stress = son of Nebuchadnezzar"--5:2,11,13,18,22)

\*It's Oct. 12, 539 BC, and Babylon falls to Persia (silver kingdom of 2:39). Again the humble rises and proud is humbled.
