Conquest and Covenant Joshua 8

Conquering Ai with all involved, 1-29

- Directions for battle: Unlike at Jericho this involves no miracle but just good military tactics. Unlike at Jericho spoil can be taken here. And unlike the first invasion of Ai here <u>all</u> the people are used.
- ODescription of battle: Unlike at earlier battle, three detachments are employed in a clever ruse which creates a devastating ambush. Note land given into "hand" (8:1,7) and Joshua's "hand" (8:18,19,26). The King of Ai's death makes for yet another stone memorial, recall 4:9, and 7:26. Gruesome genocide and executions suggest what? A tragic irony here: If only Achen had not gotten ahead of God!

Covenant renewed with all involved, 30-35

- OWhy meet here near Mt. Ebal and Gerizim at Shechem? We must recall the history of the spot--Gen. 12: 6,7, 33:18-20, 35:4, 37:12-14.
- ODirections for this event were laid out by Moses in Deut. 11:29-32, Deut. 27-28. <u>All</u> are involved in this object lesson for obedience, as people say "Amen" to the curses. The recent victories / loss at Ai show the possible results of which Mountain they choose to live on.
