




The summer palace for the northern kingdom was in Jezreel, some 20 miles north of the captial city of Samaria.




Heading south to Samaria, Jehu encounters two groups . . . one is pro-Ahab and one anti-Ahab.

At Samaria there is still plenty more killing to do.






