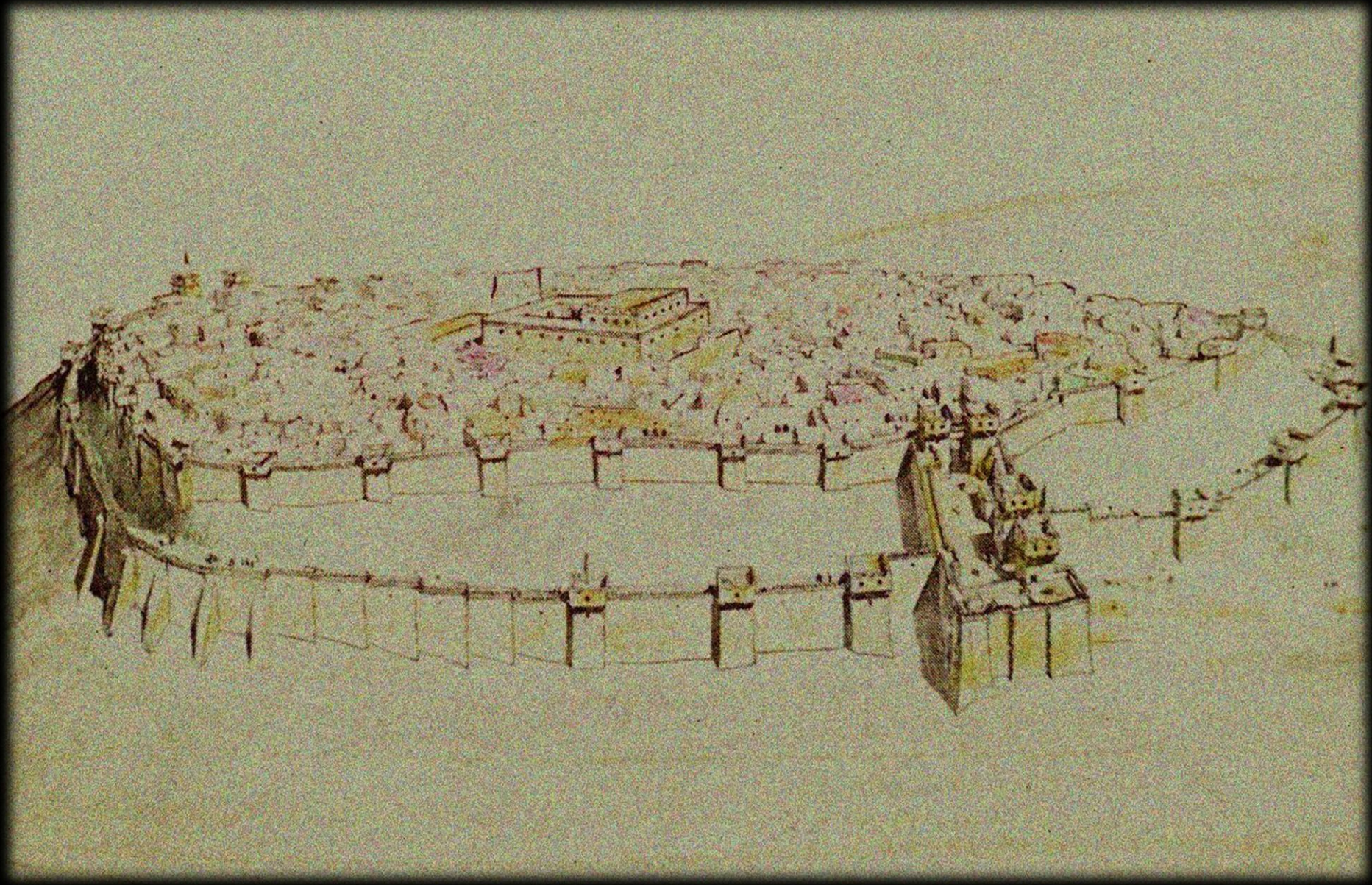


A siege = a military blockade of a city intent of conquering by attrition or by assault. The term is derived from Latin (sedere) "to sit."

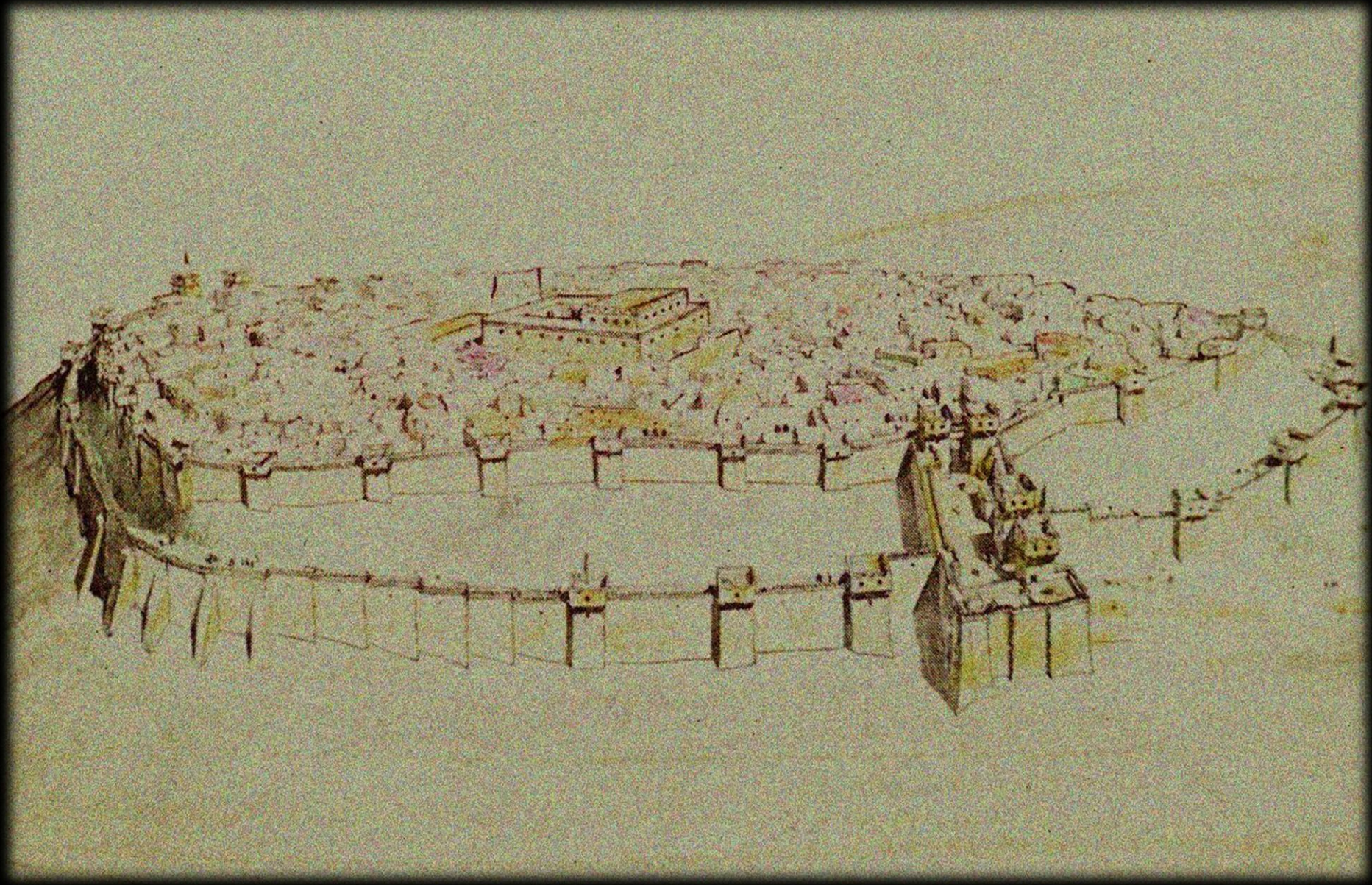
