

A study released Thursday says 22 percent of surveyed Millennials are unaware or unsure of what the Holocaust is. (KATU News Staff Thursday, April 12th 2018)



The study was conducted by the Conference on Jewish Material Claims Against Germany. Eleven percent of US adults haven't heard or are unsure of what the Holocaust was. Sixty-six percent of Millennials and 41 percent of US adults don't know what Auschwitz is.
