Justified by Faith Alone 3:21-31

God's righteousness is made available by faith. 21-23

- *This righteousness is apart from the Law, but it's in the OT.
- *This righteousness is by faith/believing in Jesus.
- *This righteousness is available to all since all are sinful. Falling short of God's glory suggests . . .

Jesus' sacrifice made our justification possible. 24-26

- *Justified = declared righteous & thus saved from wrath, 5:9
- *Grace = unmerited favor/gift, Eph. 2:8,9,
- *Redemption = bought/purchased by Jesus' blood, Eph. 1:7
- *Propitiation = sacrifice of atonement to appease the wrath of God (a term for the Ark's mercy seat)

Our justification by faith alone excludes boasting. 27-31

- *Based on a righteousness which comes through faith in Christ's sacrificial death for us, none can boast about their own works/works of the OT Law, see Eph. 2:9.
- *What kind of works do people sometimes put their trust in thinking that it will gain favor with God?
- *Justification by faith doesn't annul the value of the OT Law. See its value in 3:20,21 and Gal. 3: 24, Matt. 5:17.
