Freed to be God's Slaves Rom. 6:17-23

Though we are free from sin's rule, Paul explained the principle of enslavement in v.16. In 17-23 he seeks to motivate us to live out what we are—God's slaves of righteousness.

2 Positions: You before/after your justification. 17,18

Thanks goes to God (note passives in v. 18), see 16:17-19.

*Before: Slaves of sin (our former position, 6,7,14)

*After: Slaves of righteousness,19 (or of God in 22)

2 Practices: Your actions before/after justification. 19,20

Disclaimer—Slave imagery isn't ideal. Why use it?

*Before: presented members as slaves to sin. Recall v.13.

*After: present members now as slaves of righteousness. Our response leads to more lawlessness or to sanctification. Pre-BC "freedom" = Righteousness had no control.

2 Products: Your fruit experience is death or life. 21-23

Question: Pre-BC days "freedom" sure didn't pay off!

*Before: Fruit that shames/brings death, 5:12, 7:5-13, 8:6.

Recall death here is a present alienation from God (who is life), which is eternal for the lost.

Fruit leading to constituction (10) and stornel

*After: Fruit leading to sanctification (19) and eternal life, which a present reality (Jn. 5:24) and is ulti-

ately eternal. Note it's a gift and not from wages!
