## Why We Can Win Over Sin Romans 8:1-4

Rom. 8 will wrap up Paul's explanation of How God saves us from sin. Two themes dominate ch.8—the empowering ministry of the Holy Spirit and the security every believer has in Christ.

## No condemnation makes us winners over sin. 8:1

- •Every believer is w/o condemnation, 8:33,34, Jn. 5:24, 10:28, but the term and context (*therefore*, and see 2b) emphasizes we are also w/o condemnation to a continual servitude to sin.
- •The KJV adds a line also in 4b (possible copyist's error?).

## How we became winners over sin. 8:2,3

- ●The reason we win over sin = the law (authority) of the Spirit overwhelmed the law (authority) of sin and death (cf. 7:23).
- •Note the Trinity here: the Spirit frees us from sin/gives us life in Christ, Whom the Father sent to die for our sin.

## Why we should aim daily to win over sin. 8:4

- •God's goal = fulfill requirement of the *holy, righteous, good Law* (7:12). Are we really to fulfill the Law? See Matt. 5:17, 13:8-10. But how can we even begin to pull this off in view of Paul's own struggles seen in 7:13-25?
- ●Paul' answer? It's v. 4—walking by the Spirit (see also in Gal. 5:16,25), which is then explained in vv. 5-11.



To run and work the Law commands, but gives us neither feet nor hands. But better news the gospel brings, it bids us fly and gives us wings.
