Lesser-known Heroes of the Bible Tabitha

She did many good deeds and acts of charity. Acts 9:36,39b

- ◆Tabitha is described as full of good works and generous. The area she devotes most of her attention to is helping widows.
- ◆She appears to be relatively affluent and likely single since she spends much time and finances on making garments for widows.
- ◆Recall concern for widows: 6:1-3, I Tim. 5:3, Js. 1:27, Isa. 1:17.

She became ill and passed away. 37

What could falling sick imply about her death? What does this indicate about the relationship between serving God and death?

She was raised from the dead to resume her ministry. 40,41

- ◆Tabitha joins a small club of people raised from the dead. Why is she singled out to be raised? Who benefited most from this?
- ◆Compare this to Mark. 5:35-41.

Her return to life caused many to believe in the Lord. 42

Being raised from the dead caused many in Joppa to believe, as had the healing in Lydda (9:35). This further added to her legacy.

Tabitha shows us a practical way to be a hero today!
