Eve is tempted by the serpent to eat from the forbidden tree. 1-5

- The serpent = most clever created creature, Prov. 14:15, Matt.10:16.
- The serpent = satanically controlled, Rev. 20:1-3, Il Cor. 11:3,14
- The strategy = debate God's commands, deny God's judgment, and present disobedience as beneficial.

Eve gives in to temptation, and Adam then follows her advice. 6 OWhy did Eve eat? See I Jn. 2:15, II Cor. 11:3, I Tim. 2:13,14

oWhy did Adam eat?
Why is Adam later most responsible? Rom. 5:12ff., I Cor. 15:21,22

oWhat did this tree with forbidden fruit essentially represent?

Adam and Eve cover themselves in awareness of their nakedness. 7 OWhat a huge letdown when their eyes are opened! How is Satan half correct in his prediction?
