- •Lamech's sons greatly impact early civilization: Jubal (livestock), Jubal (music), Tubal-cain (forging metals). Is this surprising?

- •Eve again shows her faith by referencing God in birth (4:1)
- •Unlike Cain's line we hear nothing of cultural impacts, but we do hear that through Seth's line mankind began to call on the name of the Lord. Idea =
