## God's Grief Over a Wicked World Part II Genesis 6:1-8

## The Sons of God saw the daughters of men were good . . . 6:1-4

- oThis = fallen angels/demon-possessed men, Job. 1:6, 2:1, 38:7. oGod's response = a limit of patiently waiting for 120 yrs., I Pt. 3:20.
- oComplications result from the dreadful marriages in v.4 → birth of the Nephilim/mighty men of renown, Num. 13:32, Deut. 3:8,11, 9:3. in those days = before the flood (during the time of marriages) and also afterward = following the flood.
- OHow does Gen. 6:1-4 fit with 3:15, and other satanic strategies?

## God saw the wickedness of man was great . . . 6:5-7

- OGod's evaluation of the impact of v.2 = violence and the ruin of both mankind and the earth (6:11-13).
- oGod's heartfelt response = pain (cf. 5:29, 3:17, cf. I Sam. 15:11) = plan to blot out life on earth
- oGod's plan won't fix mankind's sin problem (8:21b), but it will prevent Gen. 3:15 from being unfulfilled.

## In God's eyes, Noah found grace . . . 6:8

This = first mention of favor/grace in Scripture. See 6:9 and Heb. 11:7 for Noah's character.
