

## ***Deliverance on a Day of Destruction*** **Genesis 19:1-29**

### ***Angels visit Lot and warn destruction will come upon Sodom. 1-14***

- ◆What a contrast between Abraham & Lot's hospitality vs. Sodomites!
- ◆Sadly, a similar episode will occur in an Israelite city in Jdgs. 19.
- ◆Why is Lot willing to offer up his daughters to protect strangers?!
- ◆Why is this happening to Lot? How could this have been avoided?

### ***Angels seize reluctant Lot and deliver him and his family. 15-22***

- ◆These son-in-laws were betrothed, which helps explain why Lot didn't need to appeal to his daughters. Were these quality men?
- ◆What does Lot's reluctance to leave Sodom suggest about him?

### ***The Lord destroys Sodom and Gomorrah. 23-26***

- ◆See Deut. 29:23 for more on this destruction. This is the 4<sup>th</sup> major judgment in Genesis.
- ◆Why do you think Lot's wife turned around?

### ***The Lord remembered His promise to Abraham. 27-29***

Though unknown to anxious Abraham, God protected Lot from experiencing Sodom's fate because of Abraham's intercession.
