

A Sodom-Inspired Sinful Scheme **Genesis 19:30-38**

Setting: Lot moves from Zoar to the mountains out of fear. 30

- ◆ Recall the angels originally had wanted Lot to go to the mountains (17-22). What possibly was the fear that caused Lot to leave Zoar?
- ◆ Contrast Lot's current situation with his previous lifestyle.

Scheme: Lot's daughters use Him to preserve the family line. 31-36

- ◆ Desperation causes Lot's eldest daughter to hatch a disgusting plan to insure their family line would continue. Was this rational?

What does the plan reveal about Sodomite culture and its impact?

- ◆ Do you see the cruel irony in how Lot's daughters misuse him?

Significance: Lot's posterity will be Moab and Ammon. 37,38

- ◆ Any idea how these pregnancies were explained later to Lot?
Notice the meaning of the names his daughters gave their sons.
- ◆ In Genesis there is a focus is on the posterity of key individuals.
What kind of impact will Lot's posterity have upon Israel?

What could have been the case if Lot would have been the leader he needed to be for his two daughters?

Do you see how our decisions can have a huge impact on us and our descendants years down the road?
