Why do we need to have a “conversion of the purse”?
Lk. 16:13, 18:25

Who really owns all the wealth/money in the world?
Ps. 24:1,2, 50:10,11, I Cor. 10:26, Hag. 2:8

Who ultimately determines our ability to build wealth:
I Chron. 29:12, Ecc. 5:19, Dan. 4:32.

What is a popular but distorted view of God’s view of wealth? Compare
Dt. 28:11, Prov. 13:22, 22:4 to Lk. 6:20, Js. 2:5,6, I Tim.6:1ff.

People Jesus interacted with about God’s view of wealth/money:

Consider those whom Jesus encountered where money was an issue.

Consider the many parables Jesus told where Jesus was either trying to correct distorted views on wealth/money or to use money as an illustration for spiritual truth. Jesus’ concern = Matt. 6:19,20.

Consider the true insignificance of wealth/money, and yet how it can become truly significant, Lk.16:9-11.
